



# Best Microsoft Word Shortcuts for Writers—and Editors

These keystroke combos save you time—and save your wrist from having to mouse up to the ribbon and make multiple clicks.

Here's a list of our favorite shortcuts, including lesser-known ones that can turbocharge your efficiency.

<b>SELECT AND MOVE TEXT</b>		
Select all	CTRL + A	CMD + A
Toggle between selecting word, sentence, paragraph, and all	F8	F8
Select word to the right of the cursor	CTRL + Shift + →	OPT + SHFT + →
Select word to the left of the cursor	CTRL + Shift + ←	CMD + SHFT + ←
Select paragraph above the cursor	CTRL + Shift + ↑	CMD + SHFT + ↑
Select paragraph below the cursor	CTRL + Shift + ↓	CMD + SHFT + ↓
Copy	CTRL + C	CMD + C
Cut	CTRL + X	CMD + X
Paste	CTRL + V	CMD + V
Spike text (i.e., cut multiple chunks of text and save them all on the clipboard)	CTRL + F3	
Paste spiked text	CTRL + Shift + F3

Left justify text	CTRL + L	CMD + L
Right justify text	CTRL + R	CMD + R
Center text	CTRL + E	CMD + E
Bulletize text	CTRL + Shift + L	CMD + SHFT + L

Insert em dash	CTRL + ALT + (minus on number pad)	OPT + SHFT + (minus on number pad)

Go to the last place you were editing	Shift + F5	
Toggle between the last four places you were editing	ALT + CTRL + Z	
Jump one word to the right	CTRL + →	OPT + →
Jump one word to the left	CTRL + ←	OPT + ←
Jump to the top of the paragraph above	CTRL + ↑	OPT + ↑
Jump to the top of the paragraph below	CTRL + ↓	OPT + ↓
Find an item	CTRL + F	CMD + F
Find and replace an item	CTRL + H	CMD + H
