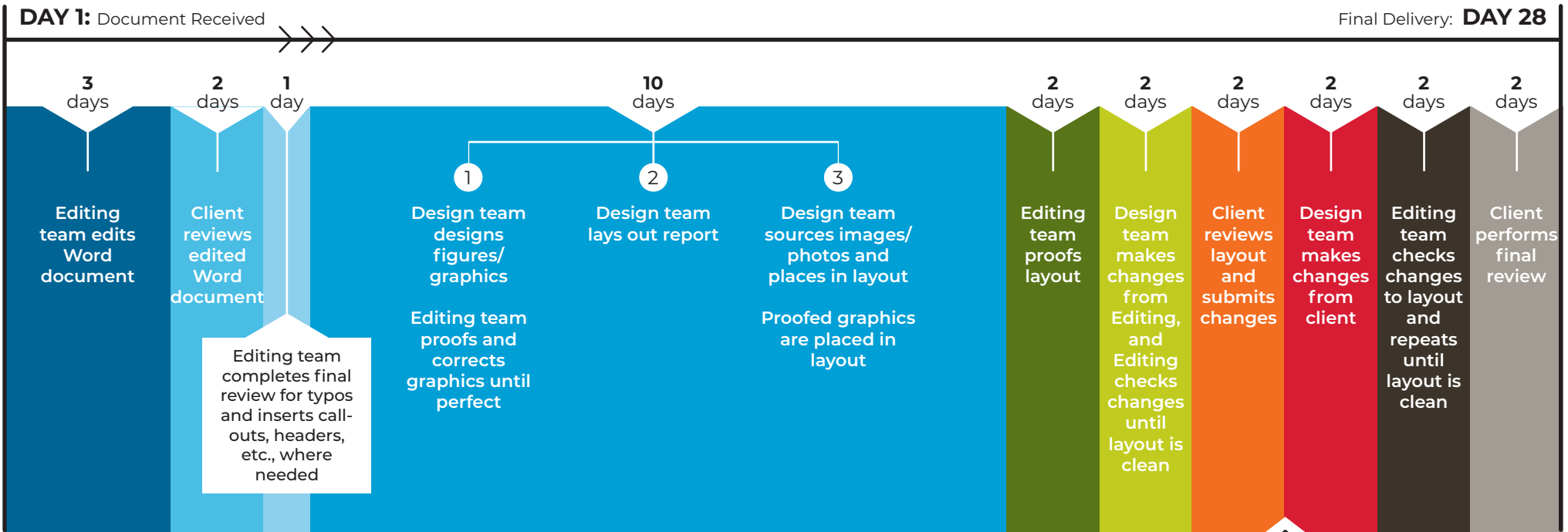




Typical Project Timeline

This timeline breaks down the many tasks that go into building a report from raw, written content to final deliverable. It illustrates how long the process typically takes and what's happening along the way. This example is based on a typical 40-page report (10,000 words) with 15 graphics.

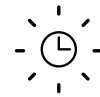


Some projects require a quick editorial review of client changes to ensure consistency



Things that add time during layout:

- Graphics provided to us:
- Have lots of text that needs to be rekeyed
 - Aren't labeled/named
 - Contain images that aren't embedded



Things that add time during review:

- Substantive content or layout changes
- Endnotes and/or footnotes added or moved
- Correcting errors in layout if Dragonfly does not have time to edit the file in Word immediately before it goes to Design
